

Prayer Confessions for the Salvation of Your Family & Friends.

Dear Brother and Sister in Christ,

Your consistent, sincere prayers creates salvation for your loved ones. Jesus (Yeshua) will bless you for joining in intercession with Him for lost souls. Jesus' mission is to save souls. Jesus' name means "God saves." Believe—Jesus will do His job!

Luke 19:9-11, GOD'S WORD Translation - 9 Then Jesus said to Zacchaeus, "YOU AND YOUR FAMILY HAVE BEEN SAVED TODAY. You've shown that you, too, are one of Abraham's descendants. 10 Indeed, the Son of Man has come to seek and to save people who are lost."

NOTE: In this account from the Bible, ONLY Zacchaeus repented ([Luke 19:1-9](#)). But when he did, Jesus says that TODAY he and his family have been saved.

Below is an idea of how to pray and confess the Word of God over your family and friends. Lay your hands on your list as you speak these confessions based on scripture. At times, you can simply lay your hands on the list and say "Thank You." Please ask the Holy Spirit to guide your prayers.

Dear Abba Father,
I am standing in faith according to Your Word for the salvation of my family and friends. Lord I thank You for dispersing angels, arranging divine interventions, giving visions, encounters, confirmations and setting up divine connections for all my friends and family. I thank You for softening hard, unrepentant hearts, opening deaf hears and blind eyes so that they can hear the Gospel, see the truth, repent and be saved in the name of Jesus. Father, I am standing in faith for the uncommon salvation of all my family and friends. I believe that with You all things are possible to him who believes. It is Your will and mission that all men come to repentance and be saved. Lord, I stand in faith declaring that Your will be done on earth as it is in Heaven. Thank You Holy Spirit for drawing men to Christ for none can confess that Jesus is Lord except by the revelation of the Holy Spirit. Lord Jesus, I thank You for personally interceding in the lives of these individuals and that all that call on the name of the Lord Jesus shall be saved. Lord, I come boldly before Your throne of grace with this petition, knowing that anything I ask in Your name according to Your will shall be done so that our Father God is glorified. Thank you for answering this prayer. I know that it is done because I have prayed Your Word and Your Word never returns void. Thank You in advance for honoring Your Word listed in the Bible scriptures below.

Faith for Salvation Scriptures

- **Isaiah 55:10-12, GOD'S WORD Translation** - My word, which comes from my mouth, is like the rain and snow. It will not come back to me without results. It will accomplish whatever I want and achieve whatever I send it to do.”
- **1 Corinthians 7:14, New King James Version** - 14 For the unbelieving husband is sanctified by the wife, and the unbelieving wife is sanctified by the husband; otherwise your children would be unclean, but now they are holy.
[NOTE: The Lord does this because you are standing in faith on His promise given in Acts 16:31 below.]
- **Acts 16:31 New International Version** - They replied, “Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved—YOU and YOUR HOUSEHOLD.”
- **Acts 2:38-39, New International Version** - Peter replied, “Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. {39} The promise is for you and your children and FOR ALL WHO ARE FAR OFF—for all whom the Lord our God will call.” [NOTE: “For ALL who are far off” means that you can stand in faith for any person that needs to be saved!]
- **Psalms 103:17, New International Version** - But from everlasting to everlasting the Lord's love is with those who fear him, and his righteousness with their children's children.
- **Psalms 112:1-2, New International Version** - Praise the LORD. Blessed is the man who fears the LORD, who finds great delight in his commands. {2} His children will be mighty in the land; the generation of the upright will be blessed.
- **Proverbs 20:7, New International Version** - The righteous man leads a blameless life; blessed are his children after him.
- **Proverbs 22:6, New International Version** - Train a child in the way he should go, and when he is old he will not turn from it.
- **Isaiah 44:3, New International Version** - For I will pour water on the thirsty land, and streams on the dry ground; I will pour out my Spirit on your offspring, and my blessing on your descendants.
- **Isaiah 49:25, New International Version** - But this is what the LORD says: “Yes, captives will be taken from warriors, and plunder retrieved from the fierce; I will contend with those who contend with you, and your children I will save.”
- **Isaiah 54:13-14, New International Version** - All your sons will be taught by the LORD, and great will be your children's peace. {14} In righteousness you will be established: Tyranny will be far from you; you will have nothing to fear. Terror will be far removed; it will not come near you.
- **Isaiah 65:22-24, New International Version** - No longer will they build houses and others live in them, or plant and others eat. For as the days of a tree, so will be the days of my people; my chosen ones will long enjoy the works of their hands. {23} They will not toil in vain or bear children doomed to misfortune; for they will be a people blessed by the LORD, they and their descendants with them. {24} Before they call I will answer; while they are still speaking I will hear.
- **Jeremiah 30:20-22, New International Version** - Their children will be as in days of old, and their community will be established before me; I will punish all who oppress them. {21} Their leader will be one of their own; their ruler will arise from among them. I will bring him near and he will come close to me, for who is he who will devote himself to be close to me?’ declares the LORD. {22} “So you will be my people, and I will be your God.”

Faith for Salvation Scriptures (continued)

- **Jeremiah 31:16-17, New International Version** - This is what the LORD says: “Restrain your voice from weeping and your eyes from tears, for YOUR WORK WILL BE REWARDED,” declares the LORD. “They will return from the land of the enemy. {17} So there is hope for your future,” declares the LORD. “Your children will return to their own land.
- **Jeremiah 32:38-41, New International Version** - They will be my people, and I will be their God. {39} I will give them singleness of heart and action, so that they will always fear me for their own good and the good of their children after them. {40} I will make an everlasting covenant with them: I will never stop doing good to them, and I will inspire them to fear me, so that they will never turn away from me. {41} I will rejoice in doing them good and will assuredly plant them in this land with all my heart and soul.
- **Joel 2:28, New International Version** - ‘And afterward, I will pour out my Spirit on all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your old men will dream dreams, your young men will see visions.
- **Luke 18:5-7, Living Bible** 4-5 The judge ignored her for a while, but eventually she got on his nerves. “‘I fear neither God nor man,’ he said to himself, ‘but this woman bothers me. I’m going to see that she gets justice, for she is wearing me out with her constant coming!’” 6 Then the Lord said, “If even an evil judge can be worn down like that, 7 don’t you think that God will surely give justice to his people who plead with him day and night?”
- **Luke 11:9-10, Living Bible** - 9 And so it is with prayer—keep on asking and you will keep on getting; keep on looking and you will keep on finding; knock and the door will be opened. 10 Everyone who asks, receives; all who seek, find; and the door is opened to everyone who knocks.
- **Mark 11:22-24, Living Bible** - 22-23 In reply Jesus said to the disciples, “If you only have faith in God—this is the absolute truth—you can say to this Mount of Olives, ‘Rise up and fall into the Mediterranean,’ and your command will be obeyed. All that’s required is that you really believe and have no doubt! 24 Listen to me! You can pray for anything, and if you believe, you have it; it’s yours!
